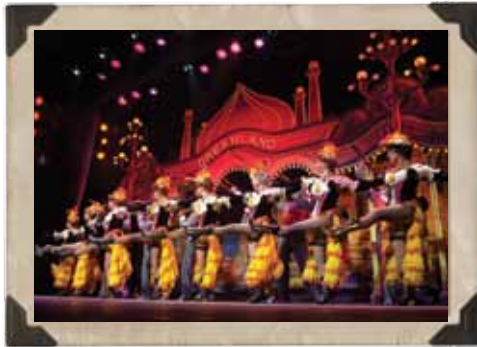

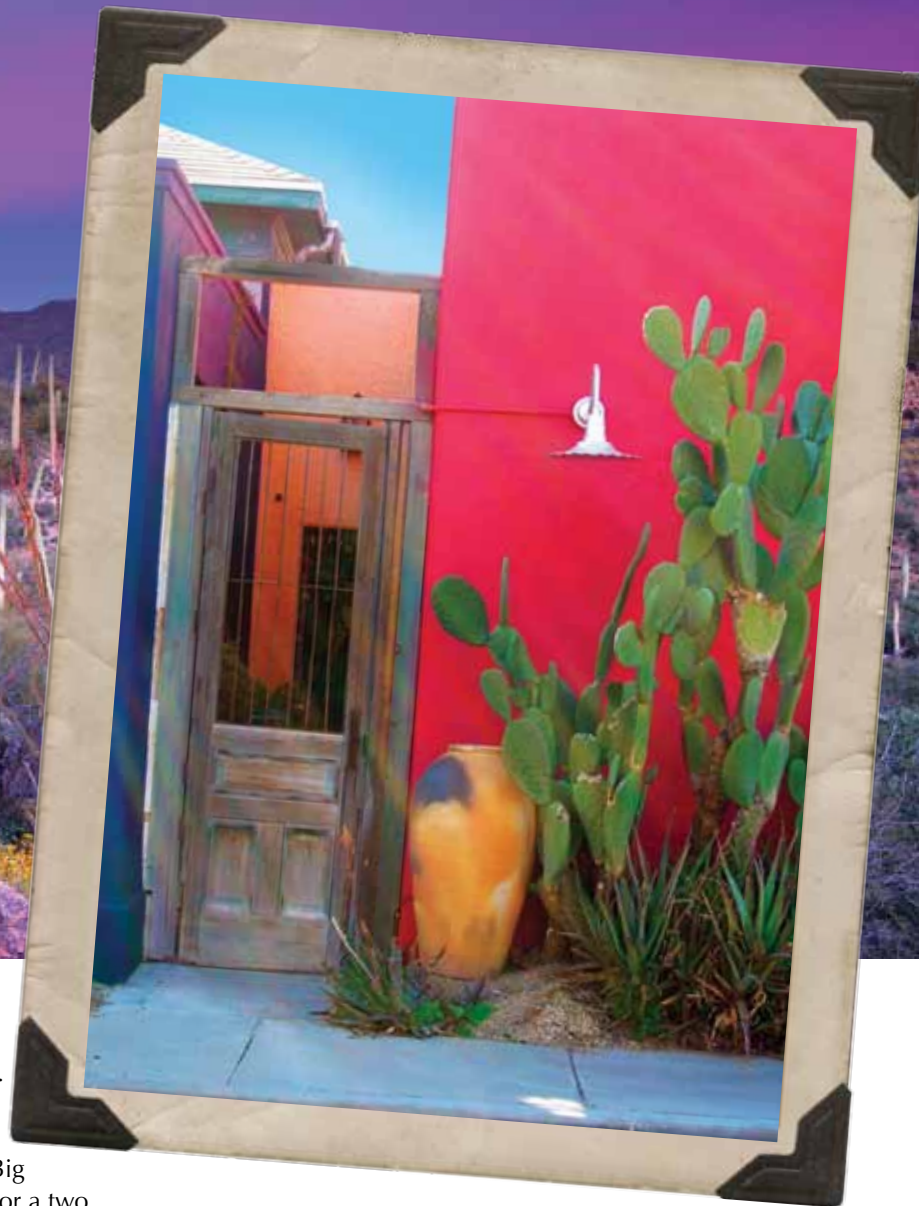

DAYS 1, 2, 3 - HOME TO ALBUQUERQUE

We become snowbirds as we leave winter behind and begin our journey to the warm Southwest! We overnight in Kansas City & Oklahoma City on the way. We will visit Oklahoma City Bombing Memorial, a “Symbolic Memorial” honoring the victims of this tragedy. On the way to Albuquerque, enjoy lunch at Big Texan Steakhouse.
