

Day 1 - Home to Chicago

Today we depart for a beautiful fall foliage tour of French Canada. We'll enjoy lunch at an R & J favorite restaurant along the way. We will spend the night in the Chicago area.

Day 2 - Chicago to London

Day 3 - London to Toronto

Day 4 - Toronto
