

Day 1 - Home to Quincy, IL

Our adventure south to experience the breathtaking beauty and fragrance of the Dogwood & Azalea blossoms begins today! Day 3 - Sikeston to Charleston, MO

Day 4 - Sikeston to Charleston

Watch the pig races or tour the lovely tree lined streets in a horse-drawn carriage (on own). Enjoy a refreshing treat at the included ice cream social. As daylight gives way to darkness, volunteers begin to line the streets with 6,000 white luminaries that encompass the entire Dogwood- Azalea Trail; plus residents turn spotlights on banks of azaleas and candles line the sidewalks. We'll return to our hotel later in the evening after this truly special candlelight experience!

Day 5 - Sikeston to Bloomington, IL
