Springtime in beautiful Georgia and South Carolina brings a profusion of color to the gardens of Charleston, Savannah, and along the Blue Ridge Parkway. Enjoy great entertainment in Myrtle Beach which some say is the "Branson-by-the-sea!" Tour many beautiful plantations and gardens graced with more colors than the rainbow!

### Day 1 - Home to Bloomington


