





## MAUI - OCEANVIEW ROOMS







### **DAILY ITINERARY**

#### Day 1 - Home to Honolulu/Waikiki

Fly to Honolulu today. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your hassle free flight. Check into the beautiful Sheraton Waikiki Beach Resort with partial Oceanview rooms. #### Day 2 - Honolulu/Waikiki

Tour Pearl Harbor National Memorial Park. Cruise by Navy Launch to the sunken USS Arizona. This is a moment you won't forget as your thoughts turn to Dec. 7, 1941 and the beginning of World War II. This impressive Memorial to the 1,102 men still entombed will be a special moment of the trip. Sightseeing includes Hawaii's State Capitol, Iolani Palace, Punchbowl, and Honolulu lookout. Motor through lush rain forest to the Nuuanu Pali Lookout for a scenic view of Honolulu and the valley below. Enjoy an included dinner in the heart of Honolulu this evening.

#### Day 3 - Honolulu/Waikiki




