OAHU - Partial OCEANVIEW ROOMS





Day 1 - Home to Honolulu/Waikiki

Like the Grand Canyon, the lines along the canyon's walls indicate the different volcanic eruptions and lava flows that have occurred over the centuries.

Day 6 - Kauai to Maui
