## Day 1 - Home to Waco, TX

Today we leave our Minnesota winter wonderland and fly to Dallas. We'll take a short drive to Waco, our home for the next two evenings.

## Day 2 - Waco

This morning we will welcome a local step-on guide that will show us some of the sites made famous by HGTV's Fixer Upper; Joanna & Chip Gaines! We'll head downtown to Harp Design, and see the secrets of Cameron Park, before a unique stop at the Magnolia Market and the Silos - there's something here for everyone! You will have lunch on your own at one of the Market's food trucks. Later we will visit the Texas Ranger Hall of Fame and Museum, which is dedicated to the history and more, of the legendary Texas Rangers - the oldest state law enforcement agency in the nation and an enduring symbol of Texas and the American West. We will enjoy dinner together. What a great day!

## Day 3 - Waco to San Antonio, TX

After breakfast at the hotel, we will visit the Dr. Pepper Museum, where we will hear the story of the invention and history of bottling this 1885 soft drink. ## Day 5 - San Antonio



After returning to San Antonio, we'll once again kickback at the hotel or you may explore some more of the Riverwalk and city on your own.

## Day 7 – San Antonio






