DAY 1 HOME TO WINONA

Welcome aboard! Today we depart for a fantastic fall adventure in Minnesota and Wisconsin. Our journey begins as we motor south along the St. Croix River with lunch enroute and a planned stop at the National Eagle Center in Wabasha for an interesting show with one of their live, rescued eagles. Then we will head to Fountain City, WI to Elmer's Toy Museum, a unique museum that's home to thousands of treasures: antique toys, dolls, real and toy classic cars. After checking into The Plaza Hotel & Suites in Winona, we'll enjoy a fine dining experience at Signatures Restaurant, complete with a breathtaking view.

DAY 2 WINONA TO EAU CLAIRE

DAY 3 EAU CLAIRE TO BAYFIELD

Continue onto Bayfield for a scrumptious, 5-course dinner like no other at the Old Rittenhouse Inn. We'll overnight at the Bayfield Inn, right on the shores of Lake Superior.

DAY 4 BAYFIELD & MADELINE ISLAND
