
Day 2 - Lake Geneva to Shipshewana, IN

Afterwards we'll take in the village all decorated in its fall splendor during our ride in a real Amish buggy. Then time will be given to enjoy the lovely town of Shipshewana as you have lunch on your own and time to shop. We gather back together with our guide for a special Q&A session with an Amish teacher in a one-room schoolhouse. We'll thoroughly enjoy this interactive and enlightening experience! If time permits, we'll then drive the Amish backroads. Our last tour stop will be at Carolyn's Kitchen where we'll meet Orly & Carolyn, Amish jam makers, who will show us how they make their all-natural jams. A private tasting allows us to savor their all-natural fruity goodness! Afterwards, dinner will be served buffet style before our evening entertainment provided by none other than Daniel O'Donnell! This affable and unassuming Irish born singer brings a charismatic and engaging stage presence with his mix of country and Irish folk music.
