






MAP AT A GLANCE



Day 1 - Home to Lake Geneva, WI

Off we go through the countryside of Wisconsin, hopefully catching stunning fall color out our windows as we motor along! Afterwards, a few hours are free this afternoon to explore the shops of downtown Lake Geneva, walk along the shoreline path past impressive homes both old and new, settle onto a bench and take in the lake view, or relax at the hotel. Dinner tonight is a pizza party before we head to The Tristan Crist Magic Theatre to experience this grand illusionist perform magic up-close and personal! Day 3 - Lake Geneva

Breakfast is served before we will visit the incredible Yerkes Observatory, home to the world's largest refracting telescope. The barrel of the telescope is 64 feet long & weighs six tons! There is much to see & experience here. After the visit to the observatory, we will enjoy lunch at Popeye's, a local, popular restaurant located in downtown Lake Geneva. Then we will visit the Lake Geneva Museum, which captures the history of the Geneva Lakes Area over many decades to the present. The artifact collections of







furniture, clothing, boats, instruments, and more are items from the area, most of which have been donated by residents whose families have made the whole area what it is today. The next stop this afternoon will be at Lake Geneva Country Meats. Here we will sample "everything Wisconsin!" Sausages, cheeses and wine, with an opportunity to purchase your favorites. We will return to the hotel to freshen up before heading to the Rosewood for a farm to table dinner experience and "America's Bandstand" Show that takes us on a trip down memory lane to our favorite 50's & 60's songs. We'll cruise to the rhythms of The Everly Brothers, Buddy Holly, Bill Haley and the Comets, Chuck Barry, Elvis, Five Satins, Frankie Valli and the Four Seasons, Diana Ross and the Supremes, and more.
