



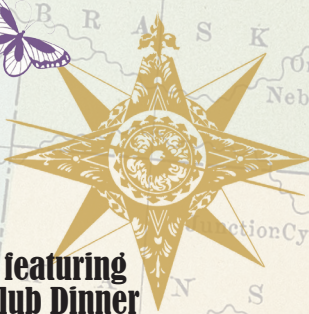

Day 1 - Home to Leavenworth, KS
